



Income-Based Spay/Neuter Program Qualifications

A spay or neuter surgery is provided free of charge to those households meeting the income, qualifications and for pets meeting the size and breed qualifications. Application must be made online and the Williamson County Animal Center reserves the right to refuse any applicant or animal deemed unqualified for any reason.

Total Household Gross Income/Persons (proof must be provided)

\$50,000 or less for 4 persons or fewer in household

\$55,000 or less for 5 persons in household

\$60,000 or less for 6 persons in household

\$65,000 or less for 7 persons or more in household

Dog qualifications: To participate in this program, dogs must be working breeds or mixed breeds, small to medium size (up to 60 lbs.). Some larger working breeds such as Great Pyrenees may also apply.

No designer dogs, pet store or breeder dogs will be accepted. Must be 12 weeks through 10 years of age and in good health.

Cat qualifications: Cats must be indoor pets; 8 weeks through 10 years of age; 2 lbs. or larger and in good health.
